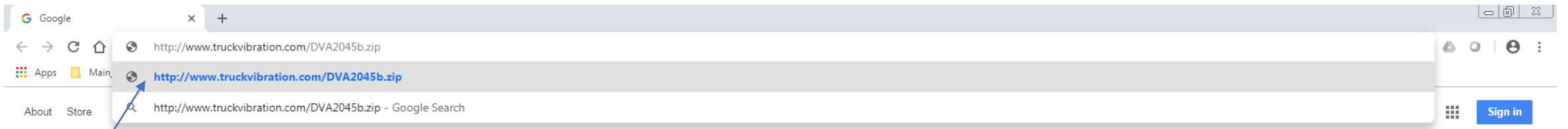

# Before you begin

1. Uninstall previous versions of DVA via Control Panel > “Programs and Features”. DVA installations will either be listed as “DVA” or “Driveline Vibration Analyzer (DVA)”, depending on the version.
2. Restart PC
3. Proceed to next page

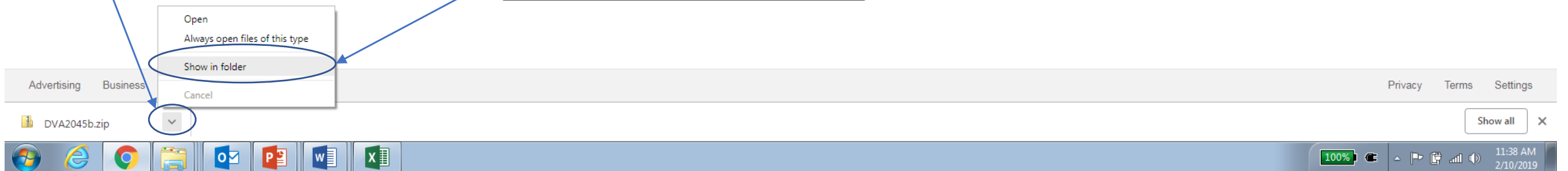

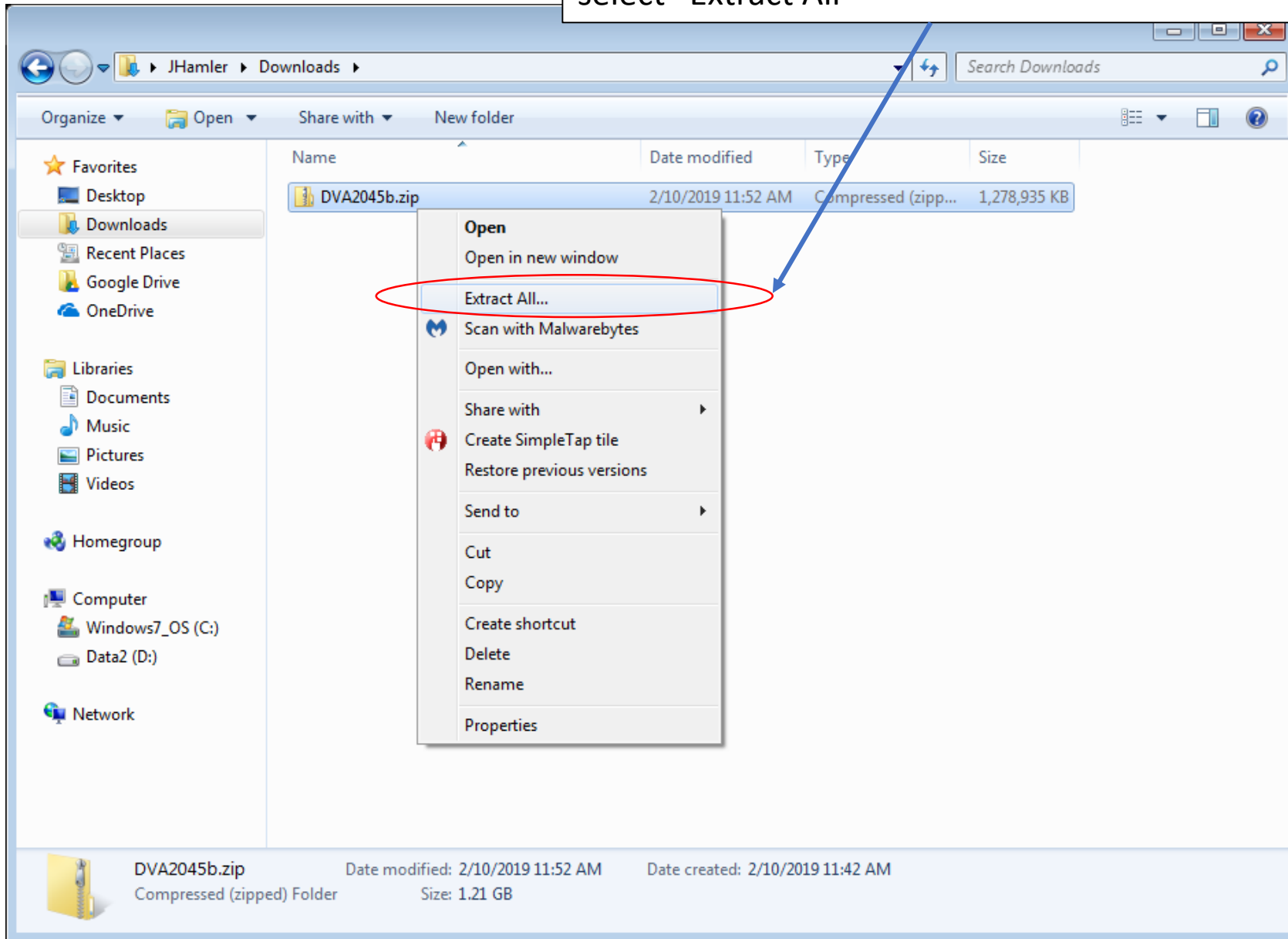


1. After download is complete, click on the arrow below (note the download may take a while depending on internet connection speed, as the installer download is 1.2 GB)

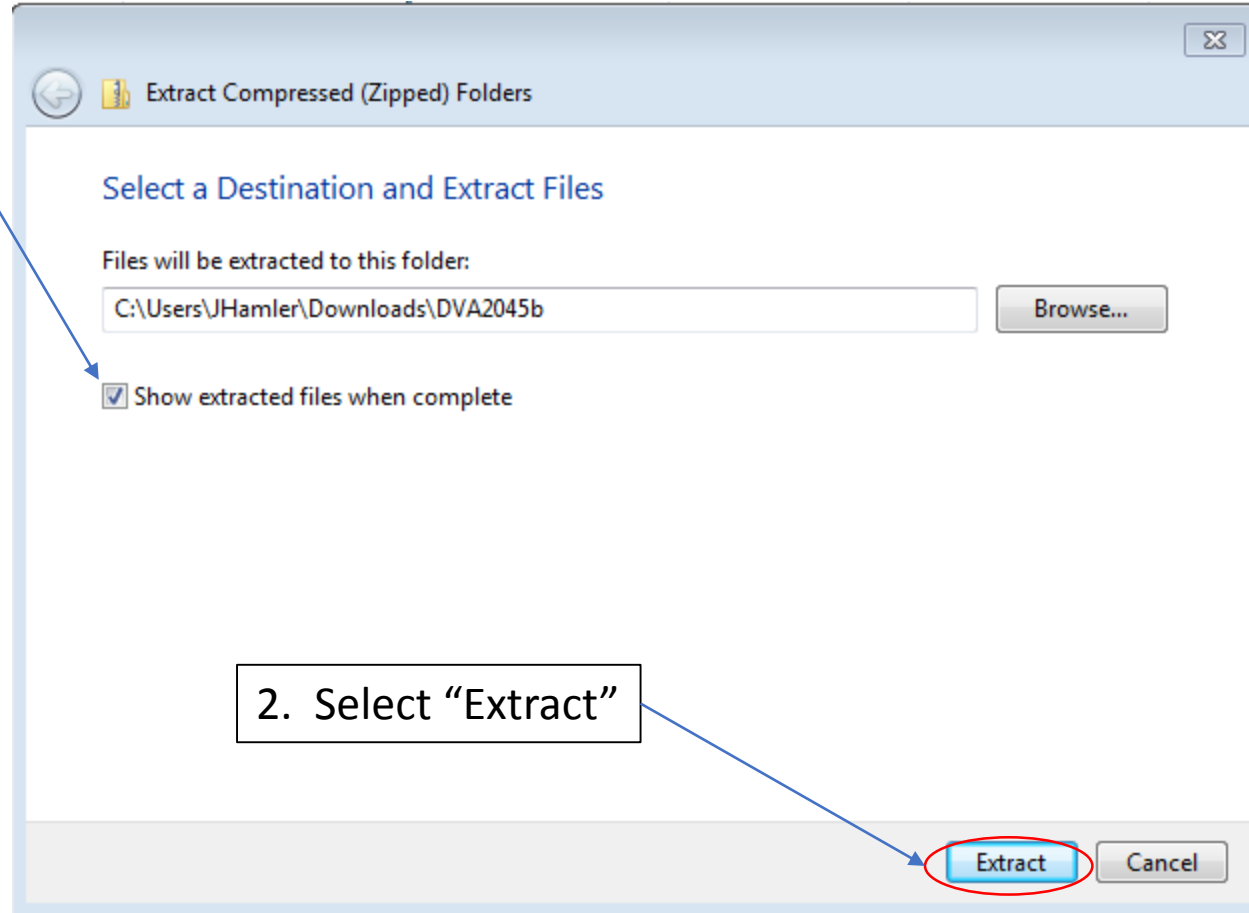
2. Select "Show in folder"



Right click on the downloaded zip file and select "Extract All"

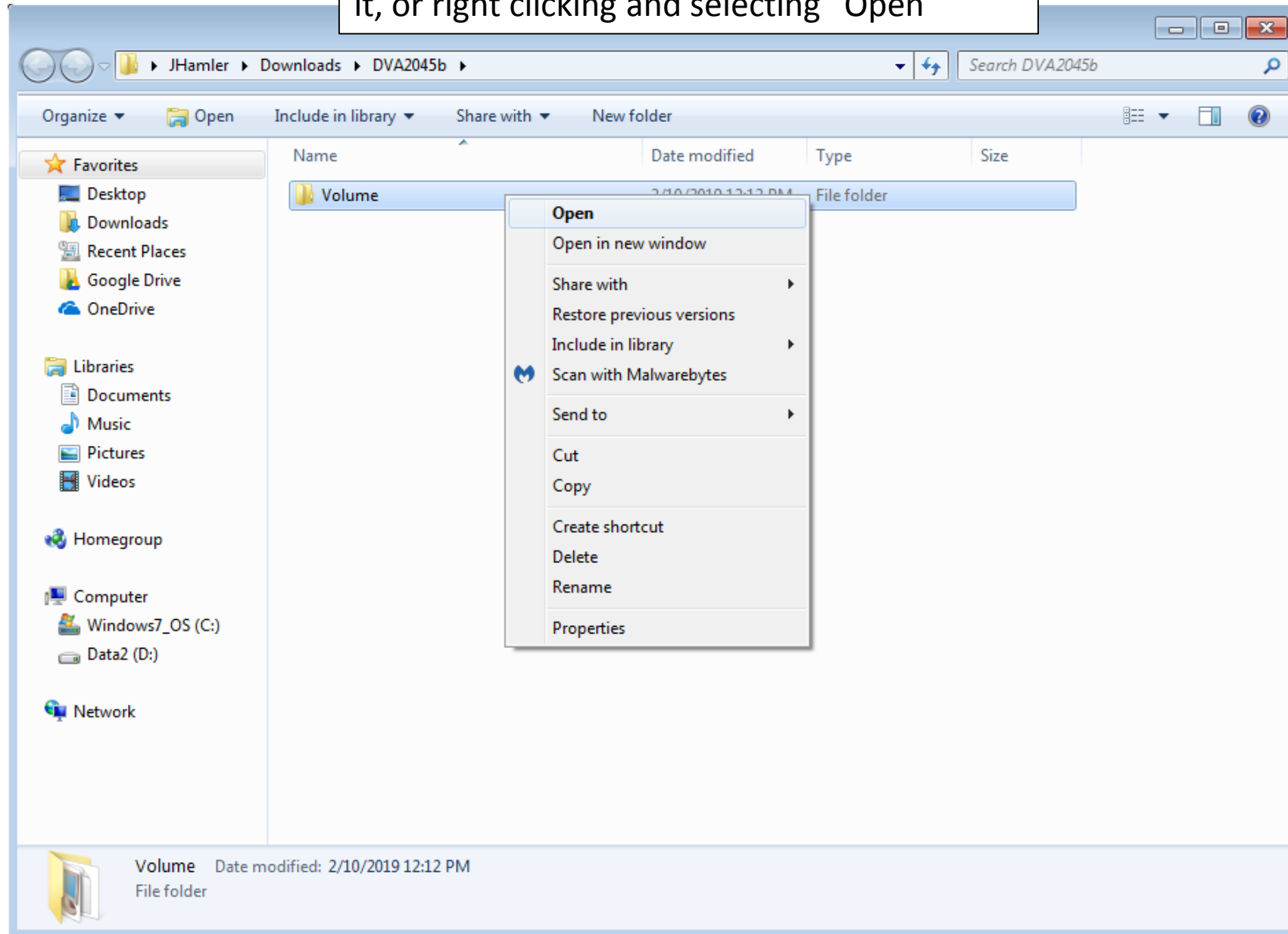


1. Check "Show extracted files when complete"

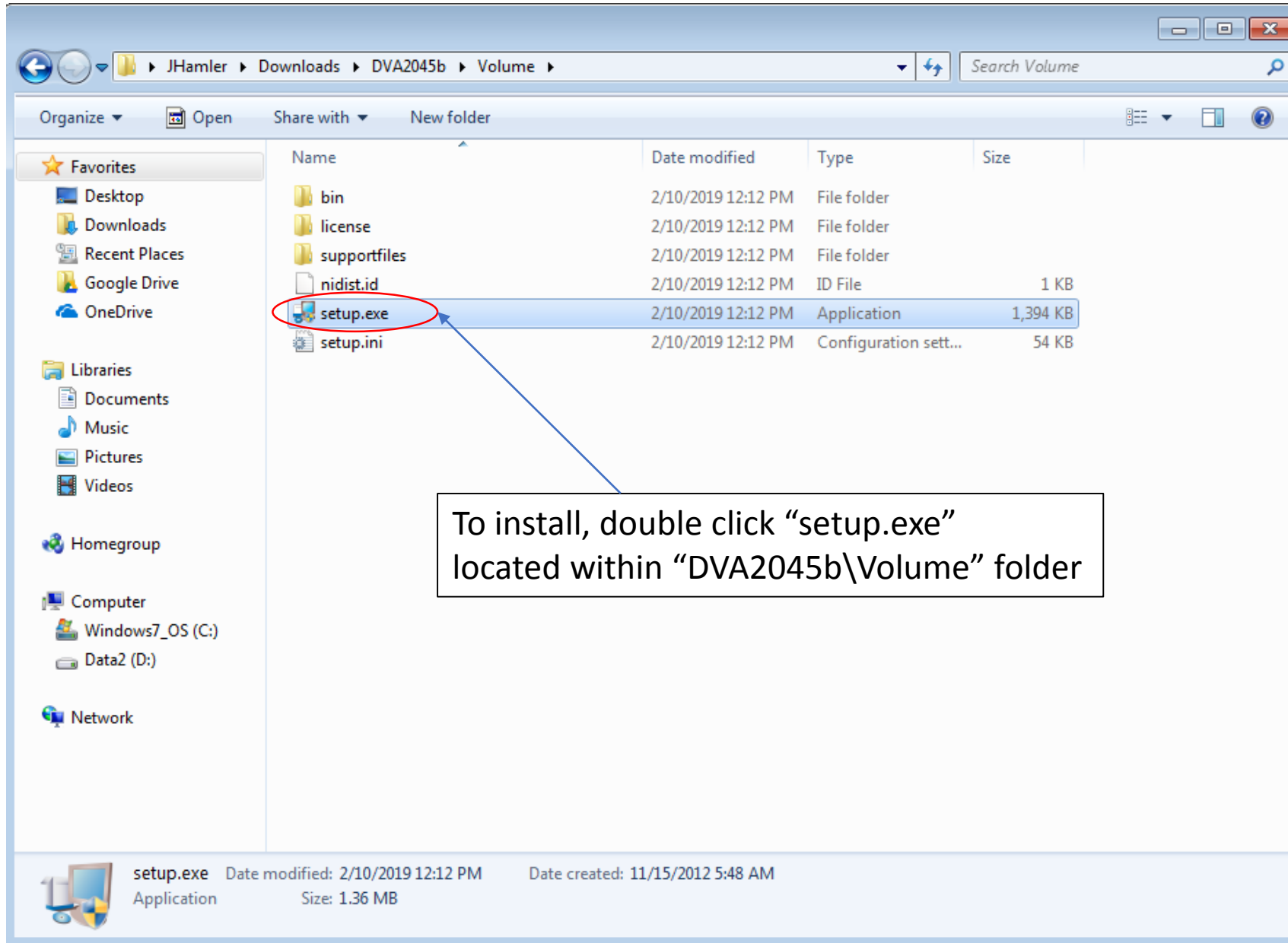


2. Select "Extract"

Open "Volume" folder by double clicking on it, or right clicking and selecting "Open"







# Install

- Follow installer prompts and select defaults.
- After the program installs, it is recommended to restart the PC before plugging in the DAQ box.
- After restart, plug in the DAQ box via USB (if your system has the 1<sup>st</sup> generation externally powered USB box, plug in wall charger or DC charger in back of box and turn on power switch).
- Wait for Windows to recognize the hardware and install the drivers.
- When the power and active lights are on, start the DVA software by double clicking on the desktop icon called “DVA”.
